**ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA**

**No. 26 of 1993**

AN ACT to provide Supplementary Appropriation for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year 1993.

[ 16th December, 1993 ]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1993. **Short title.**

2. The sums set forth in the Schedule amounting to the sum of Four million, five hundred and ninety-seven thousand, two hundred and twenty-two dollars (\$4,597,222.00) which sums have been drawn from the Consolidated Fund and have been paid for the services of Antigua and Barbuda during the year 1993 in addition to the sums granted by the Appropriation Act, 1993 are declared to have been lawfully paid and appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the services mentioned in the Schedule. **Supplementary Appropriation.** No. 9 of 1993.
