ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 6 of 1998

AN ACT to amend the provisions of certain Acts of Parliament.

[30th July, 1998]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Law Revision (Miscellaneous) (Amendment) (No. 3) Act, 1998. Short title.

2. The International Business Corporation Act, Cap. 222 is amended in section 5 by inserting after subsection (2) the following new subsection: Amendment of the International Business Corporation Act, Cap. 222.

"(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), no person authorised to perform any function under this section or incorporate a corporation under this Act shall perform that function or incorporate a corporation unless such person has paid to the Director the annual fee prescribed by the Minister."

3. Section 8 (3) of the Pensions Act, Cap. 311 is amended as follows: Amendment of the Pensions Act Cap. 311.

"(3) An officer may retire from the public service on or after attaining the age of fifty years, but before reaching the age of fifty-five if he applies in writing to retire at that age and the Governor-General acting on the advice of Cabinet grants the application."
