**ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA**

**No. 5 of 2002**

**AN ACT** to amend the Customs Duties Act 1993.

[ 6th June 2002 ]

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows —

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Act, 2002. Short title.
2. The Customs Duties Act 1993, is amended as follows — Amendment of section 8A (1).
  - (a) in section 8(1)(a) by the deletion therefrom of the words "mineral water" and the substitution therefor of the words "all types of water";
  - (b) by the repeal of section 8(1)(d) and the substitution of the following —
    - "(d) For the purposes of this section, white goods are as specified under the Customs Duties Act, 1993 **Tariff** Heads 7321.111, 7321.121, 7321.131, 8418.10 — 8418.50,
