ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 4 of 2005

AN ACT to amend the Pensions (Non-Established Government Employees) Act.

[Published in the Official Gazette Vol. XXV No.35 dated 2nd June, 2005.]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Pension (Non-Established Government Employees) (Amendment) Act, 2005 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 2005.

Short title and commencement.

2. The Pension (Non-Established Government Employees) Act is amended by the addition, immediately after section 7, of the following section:

Addition of section 7A Cap. 310.

"Minimum amount of pension

- 7A. (1)Notwithstanding sections 6 and 7, where the amount of pension calculated at the rate prescribed in section 6 or 7 is less than \$750 per month, a non-established employee shall be eligible to a pension at the rate of \$750 per month *in lieu* of the amount calculated at the rate prescribed in any of those sections.
- (2) Subsection (1) shall also apply to a person who, on the 1st January, 2005, was in receipt of a pension.
