**ANACT** to amend the Public Holidays Act Cap. 345.

[ Published in the Official Gazette Vol. XXV No. 57 dated 15th September, 2005 ]

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

- **1.** This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amend-Short title. ment) Act, 2005.
- **2.** The Schedule to the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 is repealed and substituted by the following—

# **SCHEDULE**

## 1.NEW YEARS DAY

The First day of January in each year When the First day of January falls on a Sunday the following Monday shall be a public holiday.

# 2.INDEPENDENCE DAY

The First day of November in each year

When the First day of November falls on a Saturday or Sunday the following Monday shall be a public holiday and on that day shall be

held all the official acts and activities in celebration of the anniversary of Independence.

## 3. BOXING DAY

The 26th day of December, the day after Christmas
When Christmas Day falls on a Saturday the following Monday shall
be a public holiday, and if Christmas Day falls on a Sunday, then the
next following Monday and Tuesday shall be public holidays.

The First Monday in May

The First Monday in August

## 8. NATIONAL HEROES DAY
