- 1.** This Act may be cited as the Currency Interpretation Act. **Short title.**
- 2.** In this Act "law" includes any Act and any regulation, rule, by-law, proclamation, or order made under the authority of any law. **Interpretation.**
- 3.** Where in any law in force in Antigua and Barbuda at the commencement of this Act reference is made to pounds, shillings and pence such law shall have effect as if instead reference had been made therein to an equivalent number of dollars and cents at the rate of four dollars and eighty cents for every pound, twenty-four cents for every shilling and two cents for every penny. **Substitution of dollars and cents for pounds, shillings and pence.**
