1. This Act may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Electricity Board (Declaration of Pensionable Offices) Act. **Short title.**

2. In this Act the expression "the Antigua and Barbuda Electricity Board" means the Board established under section **3** of the Electricity Ice and Cold Storage Ordinance, 1948, since repealed. **Interpretation. 1/1948.**

Service under the Antigua and Barbuda Electricity Board prior to 1st January, 1957, deemed to be service in a pensionable office.

3. For the purpose of computing the pensions and gratuities under the Pensions Act, or any law amending, repealing, or substituted for the same, the persons mentioned in the Schedule (and of such other former employees of the Antigua and Barbuda Electricity Board as the Governor-General, in his discretion, may from time to time direct), the service of each of those persons prior to the 1st day of January, 1957, under the Antigua and Barbuda Electricity Board shall be deemed to have been service in a pensionable office under the Government.
