1. This Act may be cited as the Public Notices Act. **Short title.**

2. In this Act— **Interpretation.**

"document" includes any application, appointment, by-law, jury list, minute of proceedings, notification, notice, order, proceedings, request, return, or rule.

"local newspaper" means any newspaper published in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Where by any Act passed before or after the commencement of this Act or by any by-law, regulation, or instrument made thereunder it is prescribed that any document, matter, meeting, sale, or thing of any kind whatsoever **Notices required by law to be inserted in local newspaper may be published as Cabinet shall direct.**

or notice of such document, matter, meeting, sale, or thing shall be published or advertised in any local newspaper whether in addition to publication or advertisement thereof in the *Gazette* or not, it shall be lawful for the Cabinet, notwithstanding the provisions of any such Act, by-law, regulation, or instrument, to order and direct that such document, matter, meeting, sale or thing, or notice thereof shall be published or advertised in such manner and form as the Cabinet may in and by such order prescribe.

Publication under order of Cabinet, to have effect as publication in local newspaper.

4. Every such order of the Cabinet may be in either special or general terms and shall be published in the *Gazette*; and every publication and advertisement made in pursuance of such order shall have the same force and effect as if the same had been published or advertised in a local newspaper as originally directed by the Act, by-law, regulation, or instrument requiring the same to be published or advertised.
