1. This Act may be cited as the Treasury Act. Short title.
  
2. It shall be lawful for the Public Service Commission to appoint an Accountant-General and such other officers of the Treasury department as may from time to time be necessary. Appointment of Accountant-General and officers.
  
3. All moneys payable to Her Majesty by virtue of any Act passed, or to be passed, the appropriation and application of which is not otherwise directed, shall be paid to the Accountant-General for the use of Antigua and Barbuda. Certain moneys to be paid into the Treasury.
  
4. The persons appointed under this Act shall be the Treasury Officers of Antigua and Barbuda. Treasury Officers.
