1. This Act may be cited as the Bryson Pier Act. **Short title.**
 2. It shall be lawful for the Government to construct in St. John's Harbour to the east of Fort James a pier in the position and of the dimensions set out in the Schedule. **Construction of pier.**
 3. The Pier to be constructed in accordance with the provisions of this Act shall be named the "Bryson Pier". **Name of pier.**

Position of pier 257 feet from south-east corner of
Fort James Wall.

Length ” 540 feet.

Width ” 6 feet 4 inches.

Pier to terminate with a T piece 60 feet long.
