**THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY SKILLED NATIONALS (APPLICATION FEES)
REGULATIONS, 2008 made in exercise of the powers contained in sections 15(2) of the Ca-
ribbean Community Skills Nationals Act, 1997, (No. 3 of 1997)**

1. Short title and coming into force

This Regulations may be cited as the Caribbean Community Skilled Nationals (Application Fees) Regulations, 2008 and come into force as of the 1st June 2008.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations, “principal Act” means the Caribbean Community Skilled National Act, 1997, (No. 3 of 1997.)

3. Application fee

The fee that must accompany an application for a certificate under the principal Act is Three Hundred Eastern Caribbean Dollars.

4. Verification fee

The fee that must accompany an application for verification of a certificate under the principal Act is One Hundred Eastern Caribbean Dollars.
