AN ACT to amend The Evidence (Special Provisions) Act 2009 No. 5 of 2009 in order to confer on officers of the Office of National Drug and Money Laundering Control Policy certain powers already exercisable by the police under the Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows-

1. Short Title

This Act may be cited as The Evidence (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 2017.

2. Interpretation

In this Act, the “principal Act” means The Evidence (Special Provisions) Act 2009, No. 5 of 2009

3. Amendment of section 57 of the principal Act

Section 57 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (9) by inserting after the words “police officer” the words “or an officer of the ONDCP”.

4. Amendment of section 60 the principal Act

Section 60 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by inserting after the words “police officer” the words “or an officer of the ONDCP”.
