**AN ACT** to amend the Larceny Act Cap. 241 to increase the penalty for using a firearm to commit certain offences under the Larceny Act.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Larceny (Amendment) Act, 2017.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act “principal Act” means the Larceny Act, Cap. 241.

**3. Amendment of section 33A of the principal Act**

Section 33A of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following —

“(1) Every person who, being armed with a firearm commits any of the crimes mentioned under sections 29, 30, 31 or 33 shall be liable on conviction to a term of imprisonment not exceeding thirty-five years.”
