ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 9 of 1993

AN ACT to provide for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1993.

[25th March, 1993.]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:—

1. This Act **may** be cited as the **Appropriation Act, 1993.** short title.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of two hundred and thirty million, eight hundred and eighty-seven thousand, two hundred and sixty-seven dollars (\$230,887,267.00) is authorised in order to meet expenditure for the services of Antigua and Barbuda in respect of calendar year ending on the thirty-first day of December, 1993, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a numbered and named Head is appropriated out of the sum of two hundred and thirty million, eight hundred and eighty-seven thousand, two hundred and sixty-seven dollars (\$230,887,267.00) for the purpose specified in relation to that numbered and named Head in the Estimates for the Year 1993.

Payment — how 3. The Accountant General is authorised and required from

Commencement. 4. This Act is deemed to have come into operation on the first
day of January, 1993.
