ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA
THE APPROPRIATION ACT, 2009

No. 13 of 2009

AN ACT to provide for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year ending on 31st day of December, 2010.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short Title and Commencement

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2009 and shall come into operation on the 1st January, 2010.

2. Issue of seven hundred and fourteen million, seven hundred and ninety-five thousand, five hundred and thirty-four dollars.

The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of seven hundred and fourteen million, seven hundred and ninety-five thousand, five hundred and thirty-four dollars. (\$714,795,534.00) is authorized in order to meet expenditure for the services of Antigua and Barbuda in respect of calendar year ending on the thirty-first day of December, 2010, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a numbered and named Head is appropriated out of the sum of seven hundred and fourteen million, seven hundred and ninety-five thousand, five hundred and thirty-four dollars. (\$714,795,534.00) for the purpose specified in relation to that number and named Head in the Estimates for the year 2010.
