**THE JURY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015**

**No. 20 of 2015**

**AN ACT** to amend the Jury Act, 2009.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Jury (Amendment) Act, 2015.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act—

“principal Act” means the Jury Act, 2009 No. 6 of 2009.

**3. Amendment of section 4**

The principal Act is amended in section 4 by repealing the entire section and substituting the following—

“A person who has attained the age of 18 years and over is, unless exempted or disqualified under section 5 and 6, liable to serve as a juror.”.

#### **4. Amendment of First Schedule**

The principal Act is amended in the First Schedule by repealing paragraph 4 starting with the words “Secretary to the Cabinet” and substituting the following—

“Secretary to the Cabinet, Chief Establishment Officer, Financial Secretary, Solicitor General, Permanent Secretaries, Senior Assistant Secretaries, and other heads of division of government departments.”.
