ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA
THE APPROPRIATION ACT, 2014
No. 1 of 2014

ANACT to provide for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year ending on the 31st December, 2014.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title and Commencement.

This Act may be cited as The Appropriation Act, 2014 and shall come into operation on the 1st January, 2014.

2. Issue of six hundred and forty-nine million, nine hundred and forty-seven thousand, five hundred and sixty-eight dollars

The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of Issue of six hundred and forty-nine million, nine hundred and forty-seven thousand, five hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$649,947,568.00) is authorized in order to meet expenditure for the services of Antigua and Barbuda in respect of the calendar year ending on the thirty-first day of December, 2014, under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite a numbered and named Head is appropriated out of the sum of six hundred and forty-nine million, nine hundred and forty-seven thousand, five hundred and sixty-eight dollars (\$649,947,568.00) for the purpose specified in relation to that numbered and named Head in the Estimates for the year 2014.
