**No. 14 of 2019**

**AN ACT** to amend the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) Act Cap 461.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration) (Amendment) Act, 2019.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act—

“principal Act” means the Vehicles and Road Traffic (Enforcement and Administration ) Act, Cap 461.

**3. Amendment of section 2-Interpretation**

The principal Act is amended in section 2 by inserting the following definition —

“Minister” means the Minister with responsibility for Public Safety;

**4. Amendment of section 11-Amendment of Schedule**

The principal Act is amended in section 11 by—

- (a) repealing the word “Governor-General” and substituting the word “Minister”;
- (b) repealing subsection (1) (b) and substituting the following—

“(b) remove any offence from the Schedule, and in particular he may alter the fixed penalty for any offence or prescribe a new fixed penalty in an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars.”.

**5. Amendment of section 12-Regulations**

The principal Act is amended in section 12 by repealing the word “Governor-General” and substituting the word “Minister”.
