BARBUDA LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT

**THE BARBUDA LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DEPOSIT) RULES MADE
BY THE CABINET UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE BARBUDA
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT.**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Barbuda Local Government (Deposit) Rules.
 2. A person shall not be validly nominated unless the sum of fifty dollars in legal tender is deposited by him or on his behalf with the returning officer at the place and during the time for delivery of nomination papers.
 3. The deposit shall be forfeited if a poll is taken and, after the counting of the votes by the returning officer (including any recount) is completed, it is found that the candidate has not been elected.
 4. Save as may be provided herein, the Election Rules contained in the First Schedule to the Representation of the People Act, shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to elections and by-elections held under the Barbuda Local Government Act.
