BOTANICAL GARDENS ACT

**THE BOTANIC GARDENS REGULATIONS MADE UNDER
SECTION 3 OF THE BOTANICAL GARDENS ACT.**

8.9.1901.

1. SHORT TITLE. These Regulations may be cited as the Botanic Gardens Regulations.

2. HOURS OF OPENING. The gates shall be open every day from 6 o'clock a.m. until sunset and on moonlight evenings until 10 o'clock.

3. CONDUCT IN GARDENS. (1) No visitor or other person shall enter or remain or loiter in the Gardens during prohibited hours.

(2) Visitors must be decently and properly clad, and must conduct themselves in an orderly manner.

4. PROHIBITIONS. (1) No visitor shall handle, pick, gather, cut or collect any fruit, flower, plant, seed, branch or portion thereof, or carry away fallen fruit, or cut or in any way injure any tree, plant or shrub growing in any part of the Gardens.

(2) No visitor shall climb or sit upon the fences or gates, or swing or climb upon the trees or branches, or write, cut or carve upon or otherwise deface or injure the benches or buildings in the Gardens, or remove or break or injure the garden seats, fences or boundary marks, or remove, injure or deface the notice boards, labels or notices.

(3) Visitors shall not use fire-arms or other weapons of destruction in the Gardens, and shall not hunt animals, kill or catch birds, or take birds' eggs in the Gardens.

(4) Games of all kinds are prohibited within the Gardens.

(5) Public meetings shall not be held, or public addresses be delivered within the Gardens.

(6) Persons shall keep on the paths and shall not enter on or cross any portion of cultivated ground or turf. No other animals except dogs in the charge of their owners shall be brought into the Gardens.

(7) No person shall carry any load through or into the Gardens, or shall (without the written permission of the Curator) sell or expose for sale any articles of merchandise or refreshment, or shall deposit bottles, paper or rubbish of any kind within the Gardens.

5. OFFENCES. (1) (a) No visitor shall cause annoyance, inconvenience or obstruction to visitors.

(b) No visitor or other person shall assault, obstruct or hinder, or, aid or abet any person to assault, obstruct or hinder the Curator or Keeper or any other person employed in or about the Gardens, in the execution of his duty.

(2) Any person misconducting himself may be turned out of the Gardens by the Curator or his employees.
