**THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT**

PROCLAMATION UNDER THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT DATED MARCH 15, 1929, LICENSING CERTAIN LAND AT TYRELL'S ESTATE AS A PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND FOR THE PILGRIM HOLINESS CHURCH.

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WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Burial Grounds Act, it is provided that the Cabinet may by Order license as a public or private burial ground any parcel of land, not being within the City of Saint John's, which may be required for that purpose:

AND WHEREAS a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at Tyrell's Estate in Antigua and Barbuda containing by measurement from East to West on the south side 160 feet and from East to West on the north side 112 feet and from North to South 80 feet be the same more or less and butted and bounded on the East by lands of Tyrell's Estate, on the West by lands of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, on the North by the Public Road and on the South by lands of Tyrell's Estate or however otherwise butted and bounded situate lying and being, is required by the Pilgrim Holiness Church for the purpose of a burial ground:

NOW THEREFORE, the Cabinet doth hereby license the said parcel of land as a burial ground, and the same is hereby ordered to be licensed accordingly.

PROCLAMATION UNDER THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT DATED  
MAY 6, 1929, LICENSING CERTAIN LAND AT GRANT'S  
ESTATE AS A PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND FOR THE  
PILGRIM HOLINESS CHURCH.

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WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Burial Grounds Act, it is provided that the Cabinet may by Order license as a public or private burial ground any parcel of land, not being within the City of Saint John's, which may be required for that purpose:

AND WHEREAS a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at Grant's Estate in Antigua and Barbuda containing by ad-measurement from East to West 110 feet and from North to South 180 feet be the same more or less and butted and bounded on the East by lands of Comfort Hall Estate, on the West by lands of Grant's Estate, on the North by lands of Grant's Estate and on the South by lands of Grant's Estate or however otherwise butted and bounded situate lying and being, is required by the Pilgrim Holiness Church for the purpose of a burial ground:

NOW THEREFORE, the Cabinet doth hereby license the said parcel of land as a burial ground, and the same is hereby ordered to be licensed accordingly.

PROCLAMATION UNDER THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT DATED  
AUGUST 5, 1952, ESTABLISHING A BURIAL GROUND AT  
NEW WINTHORPES VILLAGE.

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WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Burial Grounds Act, it is provided that the Cabinet may by Order license as a public or private burial ground any parcel of land, not being within the City of Saint John's, which may be required for that purpose:

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AND WHEREAS a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at New Winthorpes Village in the Parish of Saint George in Antigua and Barbuda measuring from East to West two hundred and ten feet and from North to South two hundred and ten feet and butted and bounded on the North by lands of Thibou Jarvis, on the South and West by lands of Lamberts and on the East by a road, or howsoever otherwise butted and bounded situate lying and being, is required for the purpose of a public burial ground:

NOW THEREFORE, the Cabinet doth hereby license the said parcel of land as a burial ground, and the same is hereby ordered to be licensed accordingly.

PROCLAMATION UNDER THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT DATED  
JUNE 10, 1953, LICENSING A PRIVATE BURIAL GROUND  
AT CEDAR GROVE VILLAGE.

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WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Burial Grounds Act, it is provided that the Cabinet may by Order license as a public or private burial ground any parcel of land, not being within the limits of the City of Saint John's, which may be required for that purpose:

AND WHEREAS a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at Cedar Grove Village in the Parish of Saint George in Antigua and Barbuda measuring from East to West thirty feet and from North to South eighty feet and butted and bounded on the North by land at Crosbys Estate, on the East by lands of the Advent Sabbath Church, on the South by lands of the Advent Sabbath Church and on the West by lands of Harts Estate, or howsoever otherwise butted and bounded situate lying and being, is required by the Advent Sabbath Church for the purpose of a private burial ground:

NOW THEREFORE, the Cabinet doth hereby license the said parcel of land as a burial ground, and the same is hereby ordered to be licensed accordingly.

PROCLAMATION UNDER THE BURIAL GROUNDS ACT DATED  
OCTOBER 27, 1954, LICENSING A PRIVATE BURIAL  
GROUND AT FREETOWN IN THE ISLAND OF ANTIGUA.

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WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Burial Grounds Act, it is provided that the Cabinet may by Order license as a public or private burial ground any parcel of land, not being within the limits of the City of Saint John's, which may be required for that purpose:

AND WHEREAS a certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at Freetown in the Parish of Saint Philip in Antigua and Barbuda measuring East to West 115 feet and North to South 60 feet and butted and bounded on the East by lands of Rosetta Romeo; West by land of George Carr; North by land of Rosetta Romeo and South by lands of Mannings Estate, or howsoever otherwise butted and bounded situate lying and being, is required by the Seventh Day Adventist Church for the purpose of a private burial ground:

NOW THEREFORE, the Cabinet doth hereby license the said parcel of land as a private burial ground, and the same is hereby ordered to be licensed accordingly.

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
