THE PUBLIC POUND (CITY OF ST. JOHN'S) BY-LAW, 1928
ORDAINED UNDER SECTION 3(3) OF THE CATTLE
TRESPASS ORDINANCE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND
MANAGEMENT OF THE PUBLIC POUND IN THE CITY OF
ST. JOHN'S (REPEALED), SAVED BY SECTION 3 OF THE
CATTLE TRESPASS ACT.

1. SHORT TITLE. This By-Law may be cited as the Public Pound (City of St. John's) By-Law.

2. CARE OF ANIMALS. The Central Board of Health shall be responsible for the care and maintenance of all animals impounded.

3. APPOINTMENT OF POUND KEEPER. The Pound Keeper shall be appointed by the Governor-General.

4. DUTIES OF POUND KEEPER. The Pound Keeper shall be responsible for the feeding and proper care of all impounded animals, and shall be under the direct control of the Secretary of the Central Board of Health, to whom he should periodically report.

5. CARE OF SICK ANIMALS. There shall be kept at the Public Pound one part or section suitably covered where any sick or emaciated animals impounded shall be kept and cared for separately. Report shall be made immediately to the Secretary of the Central Board of Health of any animals received in such condition; and if in his opinion it is necessary, the services of a Veterinary Surgeon shall be requisitioned.

6. VETERINARY ATTENDANCE. The cost of such Veterinary attendance shall be included in the total cost of the upkeep and pound fees of such impounded animals and shall be recoverable as under the Cattle Trespass Act.

7. NEGLECT OF DUTY BY POUND KEEPER. Any Pound Keeper refusing or neglecting to carry out any orders given by the Secretary of the Central Board of Health shall be guilty of an offence, and any Pound Keeper wilfully neglecting to feed and care for any impounded animal, or to make report of any sick animal, shall be guilty of an offence. Any Pound Keeper guilty of an offence under this by-law shall upon summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.

THE PUBLIC POUNDS (PICCADILLY) CREATION ORDER, MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (2) OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ORDINANCE (REPEALED), AND SAVED BY SECTION 3 OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ACT.

1. SHORT TITLE. This Order may be cited as the Public Pounds (Piccadilly) Creation Order.

2. CREATION. A public pound shall be created at Piccadilly in the Parish of Saint Paul on lands the property of William A. Meade.

THE PUBLIC POUNDS (COOLIDGE FIELD) ORDER, MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (2) OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ORDINANCE (REPEALED), AND SAVED BY SECTION 3 OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ACT.

1. SHORT TITLE. This Order may be cited as the Public Pounds (Coolidge Field) Order.

2. CREATION OF NEW PUBLIC POUND. A public pound shall be created at Coolidge Field in the Parish of Saint George on lands in occupation of the Crown measuring 50 feet by 50 feet located approximately 150 feet north of West Indies Avenue (opposite to the Police Station) and enclosed by a wired fence approximately 10 feet in height.

THE PUBLIC POUNDS (BOLANS) ORDER, MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (2) OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ORDINANCE (REPEALED), AND SAVED BY SECTION 3 OF THE CATTLE TRESPASS ACT.

1. SHORT TITLE. This Order may be cited as the Public Pounds (Bolans) Order.

2. CREATION OF NEW PUBLIC POUND. A public pound shall be created at Bolans in the Parish of Saint Mary on lands in occupation of the Crown measuring 50 feet by 50 feet, located approximately 12 feet from the main public road and bounded as follows—

On the north side by the road leading to Bolans Police Station, on the south by Crown land, on the east by the main public road and on the west by Crown land.
